Item 4) in the ANS foreword states that for bonded surface interfaces, the direction of curvature is not indicated. ANS Note 6 states that for bonded interfaces, the direction of curvature is indicated consistent with the right-most element forming the surface. None of the figures gives an example of curvature indication. I recommend indicating all curvatures with a + or – sign according to the lens design convention that a + curvature has its center of curvature to the right of the surface; and that we provide an example of this usage in at least one figure.




